

# On Two Sister Species of the Genus *Anchioleucopis* Tanasijtshuk, 1997 (Diptera, Chamaemyiidae) from the Holarctic Region

**Abstract**—A new species, *Anchioleucopis macalpinei* sp. n., is described from North America as a sister species to the Palaearctic *A. geniculata* (Zetterstedt). As a result, the genus *Anchioleucopis*, previously considered monotypical, now comprises two species. A key to and descriptions of the 2 species are given. Presumably, these species have separated as a result of the disappearance of the Beringian Land Bridge.
