

The Morphology of Larvae of the Genus *Argyra* (Dolichopodidae, Diptera)

Abstract—Larvae of four species of the genus *Argyra* Mcq., *A. argentina* Mg., *A. diaphana* F., *A. grata* Lw., and *A. leucocephala* Mg., are described for the first time. A key to the larvae is given. The larvae differ in the structure of the labrum, ventral plate of the pharynx, and terminal abdominal lobes.
