

# New and Little-known Asian Species of the Genus *Bucculatrix* Z. (Lepidoptera, Bucculatricidae) and Their Taxonomic Attribution

**Abstract**—Three new species of the genus *Bucculatrix* Z. (Lepidoptera, Gracillariidae) are described from Primorskiy Territory of Russia and Uzbekistan. For 10 little-known species, females are established. On the basis of comparative morphological analysis of the female genitalia, the composition of several species-groups is defined more precisely. A taxonomic assignment of all the species examined and relationships between species within the *B. ulmella* group are discussed.
