

Synthesis and Iodination of 2-(Alkenylsulfanyl)quinolines

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Abstract—2-(2-Methylprop-2-en-1-ylsulfanyl)quinoline and 2-(3-methylbut-2-en-1-ylsulfanyl)quinolines reacted with iodine to give dihydrothiazolo[3,2-*a*]quinolinium polyiodides, whereas iodination of 2-(but-3-en-1-ylsulfanyl)quinoline afforded dihydro[1,3]thiazino[3,2-*a*]quinolinium polyiodide.

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
